Dear Citizens of Glenns Ferry,

As we make our way through the last days of summer and we start looking forward to a long bountiful fall, we often like to reflect on those warm summer days. I find myself looking over the list of items we wanted to accomplish this summer and I believe we have fulfilled many of them.



We started working on the cemetery irrigation project and completed all but one phase. The city has budgeted money to continue and finish the system in the fiscal year of 2020/21. We still need to adjust and add lines to the system to cover all the area. You will notice brown sections that need to have additional lines installed or sprinklers installed. These sections will be addressed this fall and next spring.

The city park also suffered from lack of irrigation this year. Some of the old equipment finally failed and it took the public works crew many weeks of effort to pinpoint the cause and to replace the parts needed. On my weekly drive arounds, I have seen a big improvement in the park and the public works crew is working hard to keep it that way.

The city was able to secure a grant from the National AARP to remove and construct a new swing and other equipment at the museum park location. I was extremely glad to see this added for the south side of town. People will be able to relax and have some fun with their kids or grandkids. When completed we will notify every one of the opening date.

We will be continuing the runway work that is being done at the airport. We are hoping to be done with this project by October 1, 2020.

Some years back the city council voted to provide funds to extend a water line and loop to the airport. We are now looking at design costs and materials that will be needed to complete this project in fiscal year 2020/21.

It has been an interesting year and it is not over yet. I look forward to the next fiscal year and completing more projects in the next year and four months.
