Schroeder: So, the City Attorney stopped by the City Hall yesterday to see about having a special meeting to authorize the City Attorney to define the suit, because of that morning the City Attorney discovered that ICRMP was declining coverage. It wasn't until this morning, we determined City Council Members would be absent, would not be able to attend the Special Council Meeting on either Thursday or Friday, given that the Regular Council Meeting was scheduled for the thirteenth (13th), the City Attorney believed that that would be fine, proceeded at pace. It was not until this morning the City Attorney discovered because of notification sent by US Mail that there is a hearing on a Preliminary Junction on this case Tuesday at three (3) o'clock. There for its paring that the City Council take action to authorize the City Attorney if the City Council so desires to have the City Attorney appear at the Injunction Hearing would be required for the City Council Meeting, for that reason there was not time to give sufficient notice pursuant to the Idaho Public Meeting Act, this is the proper use of the emergency meeting without twenty-four (24) hour notice.
